#### **Conference Report**

The 1<sup>st</sup> National conference organized by the Post Graduate Department of Counselling Psychology, Sacred Heart College, Tirupattur in Collaboration with Periyar University Salem took place on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2015 in the campus of the Sacred Heart College, Tirupattur. It was a ground breaking conference as this was the first conference organized by the budding Department of Counselling Psychology, Sacred Heart College which was born just one year back in 2014. It adds more feather to the cap as it was done in collaboration with Pariyar University Salem. The theme of the Conference was "Contemporary Psychological Issues among Adolescents- The way Forward". This was both thought-provoking and inspiring as participants learnt with the excitement the psychological challenges faced by the adolescent and intervention methods to overcome these issues. The Conference Convener **Dr. J.Henry Rozario**, Head, Department of Counselling Psychology, Sacred Heart College gave the welcome address and the Organizing secretary **Dr. S. Kadhiravan**, Professor and Head, Department of Psychology, Periyar University, Salem gave the conference overview. **Rev. Dr. D. Maria Antony Raj SDB**, Principal, Sacred Heart College gave the Inaugural Address.

We were honoured to have distinguished keynote speakers: **Dr. Tony Sam George**, Associate Professor & Head, Dept. Of Psychology Christ University, Bengaluru in the inauguration session

and **Dr. Dr. A. Joseph Einstein** Director- Masters of Mind- Behavioral Consultancy & Training Academy, Chennai, in the valedictory session.

**Dr. Tony Sam George** gave the opening key note address on "Emerging Psycho-Social Issues of Adolescents – Global Perspective". Drawing on his extensive experience with the adolescents, he expertly spoke about the vulnerability of adolescent and how to handle adolescent psychological issues skillfully. He enlightened the participants about the anatomy of a teenager's brained temperament. It was like a magical journey towards the life of an adolescent in existential dialectics in his lecture. He also encouraged the participants to concentrate not only on adolescents but also their parents in the helping process.

**Dr. A. Joseph Einstein** gave the heart provoking key note address on "**Intervention Strategies towards Holistic Well Being of Adolescents- An Eclectic Approach**" in the afternoon session. He started the session with an action song, which brought the participants to the mood of learning. He gave a brief description on the holistic personality of an adolescent and the frame work for the intervention.

## Paper Presentation - Academic diversity

The academic content of the conference was notable for its diversity. Paper presentation was divided into ten parallel sessions according to the similarity in the content of the papers. Total 44 papers which focused on various issues of adolescent were presented. The main highlight was, out of 44 papers 85% of them were empirical studies.
