It was affiliated to University of Madras. It was the dream initiative of the Founder Director Rev. Fr. Joe Arimpoor SDB. The mission was to give priority to training rural students in Professional Social Work who would cater to the needs of humanity.

The department started offering a Masters Degree in Social Work with Community Development as its specialization from 1979 onwards. Subsequently Human Resource Management was introduced as a specialization in the year 1980. In the year 1987 Autonomous Status was granted by the Madras University to the Department of Social Work. In the year 1988, the department introduced Youth Development as a unique specialization. It was also the first of its kind in India as an academic programme at the Post Graduate level. Doctoral programme in Social Work was introduced in the year 2000. The P.G. & Research Department of Social Work celebrated its Silver Jubilee in the year 2004. M.Phil programme in Social Work has been offered since 2010.

The department has focused on the integration of Theory, Practice and Research right from its inception. The staff members and students of the department have undertaken 40 Major and Minor Research Studies, implemented nearly 14 Developmental Projects and have organized 12 International / National - Conferences / Workshops / Seminars. The department has also conducted 27 Capacity Building Programmes for the Government, NGOs, Educational Institutions and Companies in the past 40 glorious years.
