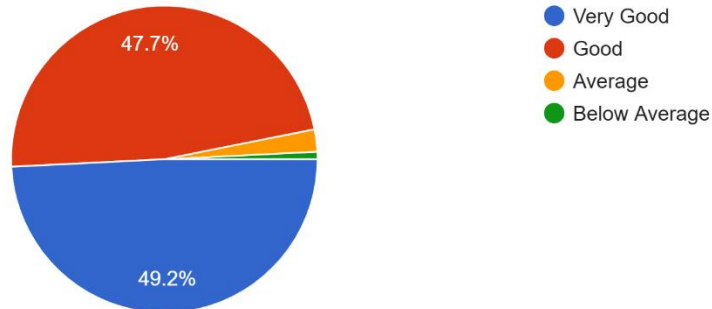

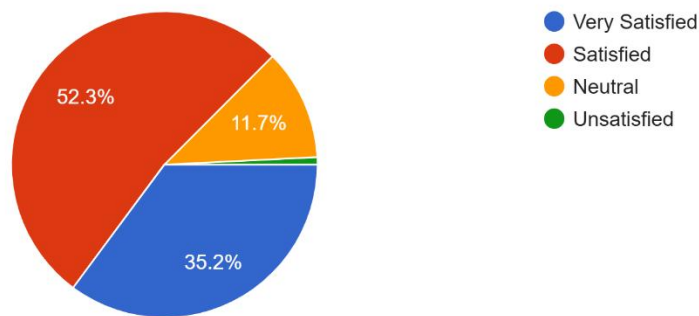
How was the talk given by the chief guests?

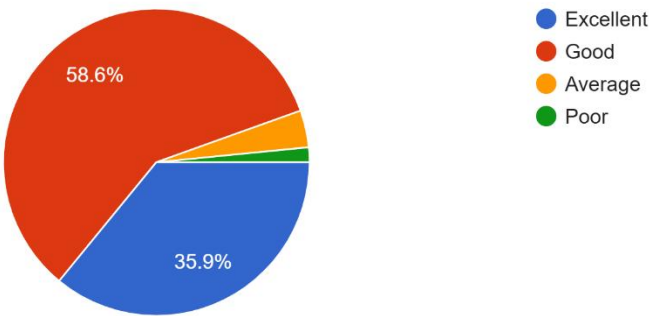
How satisfied are you with the medical consultation?

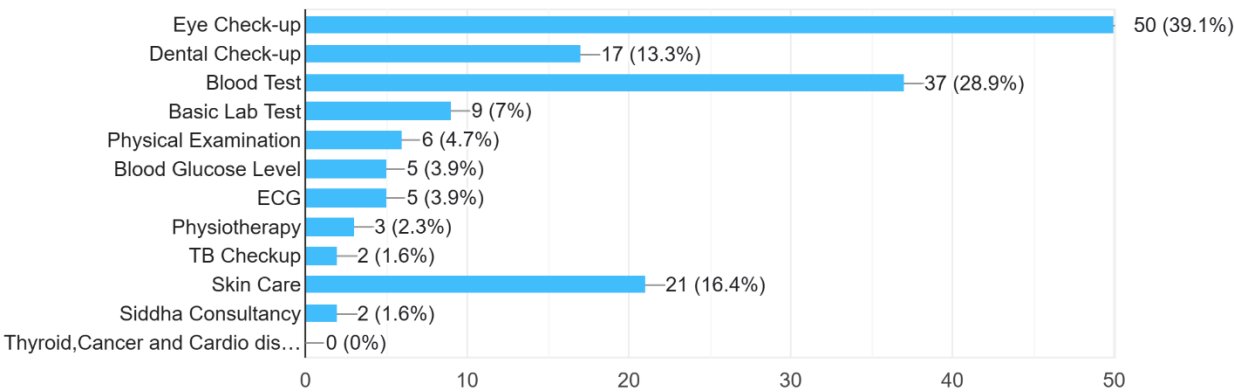
How would you rate the support from volunteers and staff?

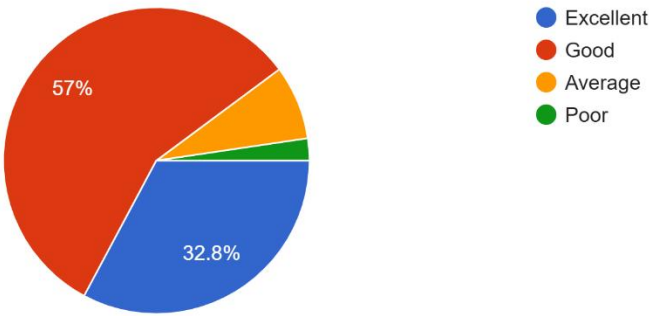
Which service did you use in this health camp?

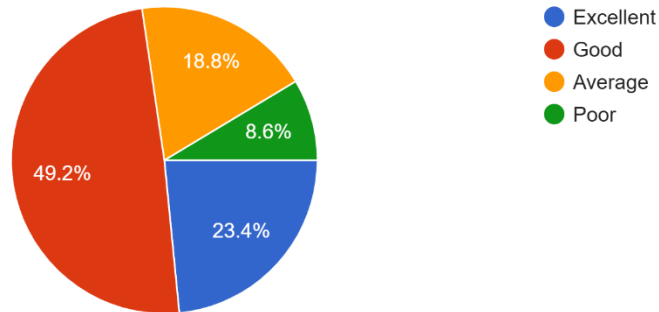
Registration process:

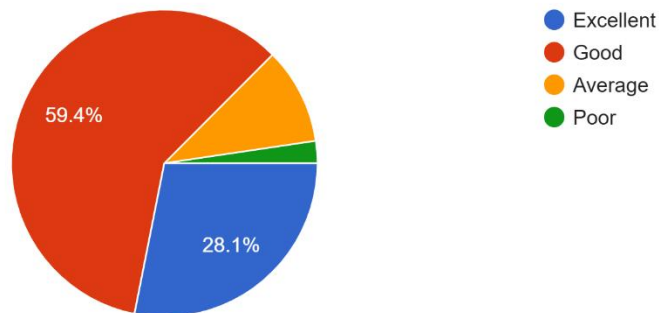
Waiting time:
