CALL FOR PROPOSALS FOR SACRED HEART FELLOWSHIP

Sacred Heart College has instituted Sacred Heart Student Projects Scheme (**SACRED HEART FELLOWSHIP**) to support the students in order to harness the talent and potential available with them. Final year PG Students may submit their project proposals as individual or group for financial assistance under this scheme. Financial support up to a maximum of Rs.10, 000/- will be provided depending on the fund availability to each project based on their proposal. Those who want to apply under this scheme are requested to read the guidelines carefully and apply only in the prescribed format. Preference will be given for the proposal which address the social problems. Two copies of proposals shall be submitted to Dean of Research, Sacred Heart College on or before 25<sup>th</sup> July 2019. ## **Guidelines for student projects (Sacred Heart Fellowship)**

1. Only final year PG students are eligible to apply in the prescribed format (enclosed)
2. Only one project proposal can be submitted by a student or by a group of students. The project team can have up to a maximum of FOUR students. A student/team must send ONLY ONE proposal and they SHOULD NOT change the topic and must not deviate from the objectives of the sanctioned project proposal.
3. The project proposed should be original, innovative and novel. It should be implementable.
4. The Project Guides needs to evaluate the project proposals and scrutiny them before submitting the project proposals.
5. Two copies of the project proposals (in the prescribed format) complete in all respects should be submitted to the dean of research office on or before 20<sup>th</sup> July 2019. Those project proposals which are not in the prescribed format will be rejected.
6. Shortlisting of proposals will be done by the committee appointed by the Principal.
7. Shortlisted students will be intimated and they will be asked to give a presentation in front of the scrutinizing committee consisting of atleast one subject expert and one external expert.
8. Scrutinizing committee will recommend the eligible candidates for fellowships to the Principal for approval.
9. Sanction letter will be issued (with the terms and conditions) and subsequently sanctioned projects will be given 100% of the total project cost.
10. The project will commence immediately upon receipt of the sanction letter.
11. The sanctioned amount should only be used by the student for buying chemicals, for characterization studies, field visit for data collection and survey. This money can also be used by the student towards registration fee for attending conferences, travel and other project related expenses.
12. Internal auditing must be done and the auditing statement duly signed by the project guide and the student must be submitted to the dean of research in the prescribed format along with the project report on or before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020 failing which the sanctioned money should be returned.
