## **Guidelines for Don Bosco Research grant for Staff**

- 1. The application form (in the enclosed format) along with a proper research proposal highlighting the research work to be undertaken should be submitted on or before 20<sup>th</sup> July 2019 to the dean of research office. Applications received after the due date will not be considered.
- 2. Only one project proposal can be submitted by a staff who will be the Principal Investigator (PI) and the duration of the project may be two years.
- 3. The selection will be based on the recommendations of an Expert Committee that will be constituted by the Principal. If desired by the Expert Committee, the applicants may be called for personal discussion. The decision taken by the Expert committee is final.
- 4. The project proposed should be of original, innovative and novel. They should be implementable.
- 5. Sanction letter will be issued (with the terms and conditions) and subsequently sanctioned projects will be given 50% of the total project cost as initial grant.
- 6. The project will commence immediately upon receipt of the sanction letter.
- 7. Mid-year evaluation will be done to monitor the progress of the research. If the progress is found to be satisfactory, the remaining amount will be released.
- 8. Auditing must be done and the auditing statement duly signed by the PI and the auditor must be submitted to the dean of research in the prescribed format along with the project report on or before 31st March 2020.
