

International Conference on Mathematical Sciences and Applications (ICMA- 2020)

The International Conference on Mathematical Sciences and Applications was organized by the PG and Research Department of Mathematics in collaboration with the Academia for Advanced Research in Mathematics Society (AARM) during 27 - 29th January, 2020. The conference had eminent Mathematicians from all around the globe who were resource persons for the 13 technical sessions: Dr. Lamberto Rondoni (Italy), Dr. J. Prakash (South Africa), Dr. Santo Banerjee (Malaysia), Dr. Asit Saha (Sikkim Manipal University), Dr. Amar Prasad Misra (Visva-Bharathi University), Dr. Sadhasivam (Rasipuram), Dr. Sreenadh (Andra Pradesh), Dr. Solairaja (Coimbatore), Dr. Pitchamani (RIASM), Dr. Rushikumar (VIT, Vellore) and Dr. Sivaraj (VIT, Vellore). The conference invited 480 participants and 132 papers from colleges and universities all around the country which were presented during the sessions. The inaugural session was chaired by Rev. Dr. D. Maria Antony Raj, the Principal who delivered the inaugural address and opening words of the conference were delivered by Dr. Lamberto and Dr. Santo Banerjee. During the second day of the conference, the second annual general body meeting of the newly formed AARM society was organized. It was chaired by the Principal, the chairman of the society who stressed on having a road map for networking and collaboration for quality research in the field of Mathematics beneficial for all stake holders. It was also decided during the meeting to organize the next national conference, to build up resources for the students, to strengthen the Journal of Computational Mathematica (CM) and to build up better networking among the institutions from which the members were hailing from. The valedictory function on 29th January, 2020 was chaired by Rev. Dr. C. Antonyraj, the secretary of the college who appreciated the commitment and hard work of the faculty of the department. He also stressed that the research in the subject to induce scholars and students to contribute for national building. The conference ended with word of gratitude expressed for all those who toiled for the conduct of the event and with the patriotic feel created by the National Anthem.
