

17th BLOOD DONATION CAMP – 2021

REPORT

Blood Donation Camp with CMC, Vellore is an annual feature at Sacred Heart College (Autonomous) Tirupattur, pioneered and organized by the P.G. & Research Department of Social Work. The coordinated efforts of the association of Social Work students and staff have facilitated in raising **149 units** of blood from college students of various departments – Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Microbiology, Biochemistry, MBA, MCA, BBA, B.Com, English, Computer Science, Economics, Counselling Psychology & Social Work Departments. CMC team consisting of doctors, nurses and lab technicians arrived at the department at 9.30 a.m. on 10/02/2021. The programme began with a welcome address followed by prayer song. The students were addressed on the importance of donating blood by the Head of the Department of Social Work.

Christian Medical College (CMC) team went through a scientific process of screening for the fit candidates by HB test and only those that met the requirements were directed for blood donation. Total number of donors were **232**. Refreshment was given to the donors. Students who were found not eligible to donate blood were guided by the doctors on how to take care of their health.
