## CALL FOR PROPOSALS - DON BOSCO RESEARCH GRANT 2023

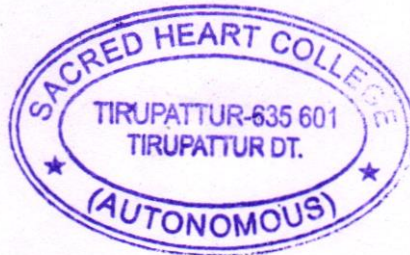

## **Guidelines for Don Bosco Research Grant (for Faculty)**

1. The application form (in the enclosed format) along with a proper research proposal highlighting the research work to be undertaken should be submitted on or before 21<sup>st</sup> June 2023 to the Dean of Research office. Applications received after the due date will not be considered.
2. Only one project proposal can be submitted by a faculty member who will be the Principal Investigator (PI). **Only those faculty members who can assure the publication of at least TWO research articles in SCI/Web of Science/Scopus indexed journals (in case of sciences) and TWO research articles in Scopus/UGC-CARE list of journals (in case of Arts and Humanities) are requested to apply for this scheme in the prescribed format.**
3. The project proposed should be original, innovative and novel. They should be implementable.
4. Shortlisting and initial screening of proposals will be done by the committee appointed by the Principal. Shortlisted faculty members will be intimated and they will be asked to give a presentation in front of an expert committee. Expert committee will recommend the eligible candidates for fellowships to the Principal for approval.
5. Sanction letter will be issued (with the terms and conditions) and subsequently sanctioned projects will be given 50% of the total project cost as initial grant (I installment).
6. The duration of the project is TWO years. However, mid-year evaluation will be done towards the end of the first year to monitor the progress of the research. If the progress is found to be satisfactory, the remaining amount (II Installment) will be released.
7. Auditing must be done and the audited statement duly signed by the PI and the auditor must be submitted to the Dean of Research in the prescribed format along with the project report after the completion of the project.
